Introductory Comments

In my articles and books (*In Search of ... the Origin of Nations* and *The Great German Nation*) I have employed a style that is neither scholarly (designed for high end scholastic journals and unintelligible to many) nor chatty and journalistic (styles used in novels and newspapers). Instead, I prefer one that straddles both areas.

Moreover, I also prefer to write succinctly rather than in a verbose manner. Life is too short to write 20,000 words when the same message could be expressed in 5,000. This will lessen the time needed by the already time-consuming reader. In addition, almost everything I write is from a new perspective, building upon the Church of God teachings – not undoing them. In other words, I prefer to value add to them with new research and thinking.

If a subject has already been written and researched, I prefer to avoid duplicating efforts, even if there might be some differences of opinion between me and the research, booklet or book. It is only if I can add value to the subject that I venture into the particular area and write on it.

For, what is the benefit of going over old ground that has already been explored? It may be self-serving and showing off. But adds little to our body of knowledge. Our corpus of knowledge must be expanded upon with more and more proofs, not rehashing someone else's writings.

Real research comes from pouring through libraries; analysis; critique; examining all points of view; knowing one's subject; cross-referencing; debating with others; contacting organisations and people for further insights/information etc. Such results in quality research and depth. This takes time - the misuse of modern technology bypasses this and leads to very shallow outcomes. There is no excuse for laziness.

Research Methodology

I think it may interest the reader to summarise the research methodology used in assembling my book(s) and papers. Writing any book requires piecing together a large array of information which has to be collected from many sources.

Skills involved in this type of esoteric research has to demonstrate an ability to think issues through clearly and then to present the information in a readable, factual and interesting fashion. It involves the following clear line of thinking and deductive reasoning:

1. Definition:

- Identify the task and the information required and plan the research
- Followed by collecting the necessary information
- Resources and tasks required are identified next

2. Strategies to locate information:

- Choose methods
- The range of sources are scoped and listed under logical categories
- I then determined source priorities – this was determined by considering which sources were the most important

3. Locating appropriate of sources:

- Libraries, institutions, old books, various other documents (and even the internet, but the latter is not that useful for indepth analysis¹)
- The next step is locating the information within these sources – such as reading the material; or scouring through the source and its index, footnotes, bibliography
- Talk with or interview appropriate people (or exchange letters/e-mail); focus groups; surveys

4. Utilisation of the collected information:

- Read the information carefully
- Ascertain the use of the information
- This is followed by identifying the major ideas or key words
- Extracting the information – photocopying, highlighting, note taking or downloading what is required

5. Synthesis of the above:

- Organising the information from the above multiple sources
- Outlining the information sequentially and logically

- Analysing and interpreting data
- Development of the bibliography in an accepted format or by standards
- Present the information in the best format for the book to be published
- Evaluate if the project is completed and ascertain if anything else needs to be added to it or amended
- Undertake proof-reading. Ask others to assist
- Have the final draft of the manuscript reviewed
- Present the manuscript for finalisation

What is normal for researchers and writers is the enormous amount of data that is gathered for their works. For a single page produced, one might have dozens of papers, articles, books, letters, hand written notes and so forth. All of this must be analysed, understood and pieced together like a jigsaw puzzle.

Any writer will attest to how difficult this is. It is not fun, but one does enjoy the fruits.

I reference as much as I can given this sort of alternative history. Non-believing historians will not agree with the conclusion of my boo(s), but they cannot deny the processes and referencing. Should I have mislaid a reference (which is very rare) here or there, I have to choose whether to continue with a particular argument or put it to one side. Such choices are made dependant upon factors such as whether enough has already been written on a given point.

A rational thought process resulting a clear outcome is essential with this sort of research. I trust that this author has been able to fulfill this and pull together a comprehensive books and papers providing the seeker with appropriate exciting information.
